PURPOSE:

Illustrate how people in a group or unit depend on one another

MATERIALS:

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Ask the group to form a circle.
- 2. The facilitator begins with a ball of yarn. Keeping one end, the facilitator passes the ball to a participant standing at least a few positions away.
- 3. That person introduces herself and briefly describes her role in the organization. (If the people don't work together and don't already know each other well, this can be a high-level description; for a team that works together daily, it can be a specific job responsibility.)
- 4. This person then passes the ball of yarn to any other person in the group.
- **5.** That person introduces himself—and must describe how his work depends on the person who passed him the yarn.
- 6. The process continues until everyone is introduced.
- **7.** To emphasize the interdependencies among team members, the facilitator then pulls on the starting thread and everyone's hand moves.
