



HOW TO CREATE REGIONAL CLASSES IN KP LEARN

Follow the instructions below to create regional classes in KP Learn for LMP Joint Staffing Training for Coalition Labor and KP Management.

- 1 For virtual or in-person classes, use course **ID: LMP:JST_REGIONAL**
- 2 Select the correct **Delivery Type**:
 - » For virtual delivery, select **“Virtual Classes”** (do not use **web-based training** or any other classes)
 - » For in-person classes, select **“Instructor-Led Training”**
